

These changes will have no impact on patients who are Bulk-Billed. This means concession card holders & children to the end of Year 12.

- 1. Patients, starting from the beginning of September, will receive an account in the mail from Orbost Medical Clinic. They should hold onto this account until they receive a cheque from Medicare.
- 2. Orbost Medical Clinic will send the patient's accounts directly to Medicare.
- 3. Patients will receive a Medicare cheque in the mail payable to Orbost Medical Clinic.
- 4. The Medicare cheque needs to be forwarded to Orbost Medical Clinic along with the balance owing.

LEVEL A: \$40.00 (GAP Payment for patient \$23.05)

LEVEL B: \$60.00 (GAP Payment for patient \$22.95)

LEVEL C: \$95.00 (GAP Payment for patient \$23.30)

LEVEL D: \$130.00 (GAP Payment for patient \$24.45)

These Fees are necessary due to the rising costs of providing general practice services. The fees are at the low end of what is considered standard practice for general practices in Australia.

# New Cancer Council Victoria bowel cancer screening campaign

Cancer Council Victoria has launched a new bowel cancer screening campaign,

#### 'Do the Home Test - It Could Save Your Life'.

Australia has one of the highest rates of bowel cancer in the world. Around one in 23 Australians will develop bowel cancer during their lifetime. The National Bowel Cancer Screening Program aims to continue to reduce deaths from bowel cancer through early detection of the disease.

Bowel cancer develops in the wall or lining of the colon. It begins when cells grow too quickly, forming a clump known as a polyp or adenoma. Most are benign (non-cancerous), but over several years, some can become cancerous. If left untreated, the cancer can spread to other areas of the body.

Cancer Council Victoria would like to encourage more Victorians aged 50-74 to complete the home screening test when they receive it in the mail. If detected early, more than 90 per cent of bowel cancers can be successfully treated.

Unfortunately only 39.9 per cent of Victorians participated in the National Bowel Cancer Screening

Program in 2014 - 2015.

Even if you feel well, screening is important because bowel cancer can develop without symptoms.

#### **Shooters Licence Course**

This course will enable you to obtain a shooters licence and possess firearms. Children aged between 12 years and 18 years are invited to attend the course and obtain their Junior Shooters Licence.

**When:** Tuesday, 19<sup>th</sup> September, 2017 **Where:** Buchan Neighbourhood House

**Time:** Arrive at 6.15p.m. for a 6.30p.m. start

**Bring:** Photo ID required

**Cost:** Free. The completion of this course allows you to fill out a shooters licence application form and apply for a shooters licence.

**Duration:** 3 hours. The course is made up of a two hour lecture covering all aspects on the firearms test, followed by a short firearms question test. Please contact Ray Moreland on 5155 9268 or 0437 366 332 to register your interest in attending the course.
